
Children ages 4 to 14 are encouraged to enter this show.

In this one-day workshop you will learn how to paint a lovely Fuchsia. Step-by-step instructions and lots of one-one assistance.

Bring a lunch and have a fun day with fellow classmates.

#### Supply List:

PAPER: I prefer Arches cold press sheets or blocks in 140 lb. If you use sheets, please also bring a hardboard and clips or masking tape to secure the paper. You may also use a good quality. Watercolor pad. We'll use ¼ sheet size, 10"x 14".

BRUSHES: I use larger round and flat brushes, please bring a variety so you can learn to use them for different techniques. Rounds, #12 or #10, and #8 or #6, and a liner.

**PAINTS:** I use higher grade paints such as Winsor Newton and Daniel Smith, but you can find less expensive brands such as Cotman that will also work. Here is a list of colors I have in my palette:

Winsor Yellow (Hansa Yellow)

Permanent or Quinacridone Rose

New Gamboge

Thalo Blue (Winsor Blue Red Shade)

Quinacridone Gold

Thalo Green (Winsor Green Blue Shade)

Burnt Sienna Sap Green
Alizarin Crimson Quinacridone Violet

OTHER: Plastic palette with large wells to hold and mix paints.

Light Plywood or Gatorboard to hold paper if bought in sheets 11"x 15"

Masking tape to secure paper to board Water containers for cleaning out brushes

Paper towels or Kleenex

Old bath towel to cover table Sketchbook, pencil and kneaded eraser

You can find most of the art supplies at Michaels Arts and Craft or Hobby Lobby, Art Department or Merri Artist or purchase online at Cheap Joe's and Blick Art Supplies. Other items can be found around the house.

Before coming to class, please draw or transfer the pattern to your paper using graphite paper or light box.

Just beginning? You may purchase paint and borrow brushes and palette for \$15.00 fee from the instructor.
