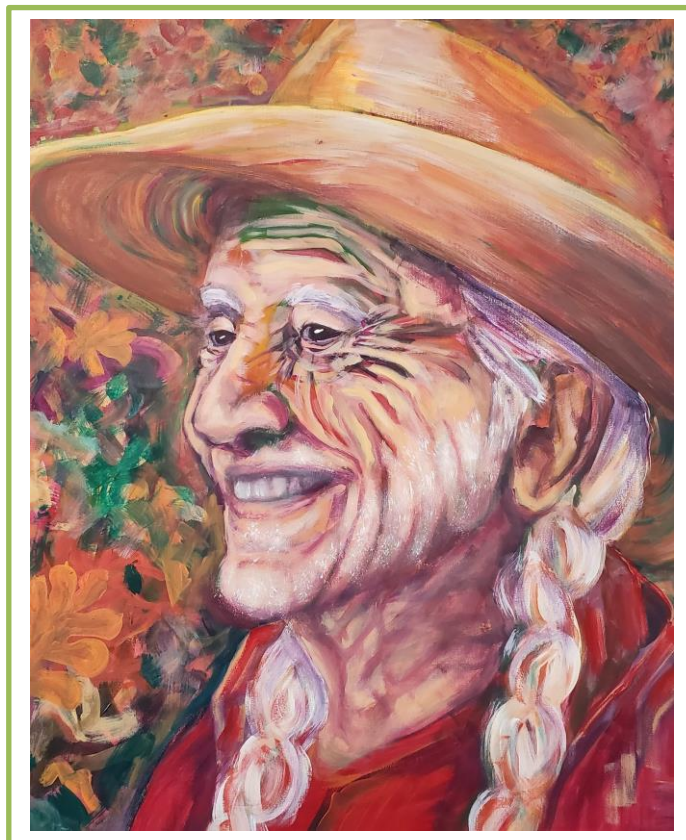
October, 2020 – “Colors of Autumn” Virtual Show

SEPTEMBER VIRTUAL “COLORS OF AUTUMN” SHOW

Barbara DiMattio judged the September “Watercolor” Show. Barbara is known throughout the NY-NJ-PA area for her stone lithographs and drawings of old barns, bridges, and houses. Her detailed work process is similar to that used in eighteenth-century illustrations. She has shown extensively throughout the tri-state area in galleries and prestigious juried shows, winning many awards for her work. She has studied at Middlesex College and Rutgers University, as well as privately under several well-known artists. Barbara has served on several art league boards in NJ, Bucks County, PA (a most prolific center of watercolor artists), and later in Naples, FL. A five-year resident of Salem, Barbara finds that the scenery here is so beautiful that her artistic interests now also include photography and all that is in nature. She is a member of KAA.

BEST OF SHOW – “WASH DAY, EVERY DAY”, Donna Lee. Unique subject with great depth of field, proper comparative sizes of multiple subjects, and excellent use of shading.

FIRST PLACE – “PANAMA PASTORAL 2”, Ginny Stevens. Vanishing point is well defined by subject placement and layered color intensity together with a pleasing palette that uses many colors.

SECOND PLACE – “PLUCKING MY HEARTSTRINGS”, Susan Hartson. Good use of limited color palette to draw one's eye to the guitar, and then to the child's face.

THIRD PLACE – “TRANQUIL GARDEN”, Dianne Hicks. Proper use of dry brush over a wash to create definition and dark areas, drawing the eye toward the only other color subject -- the red wine.

JUROR'S AWARD – “TRAVELING COMPANIONS”, Lynette Olsen. Good use of the loose style of watercolor while creating a nostalgic piece that although close up still contains good depth of field.

Thank you to the KAA Board for giving me the privilege of judging this show for the Keizer Art Association.

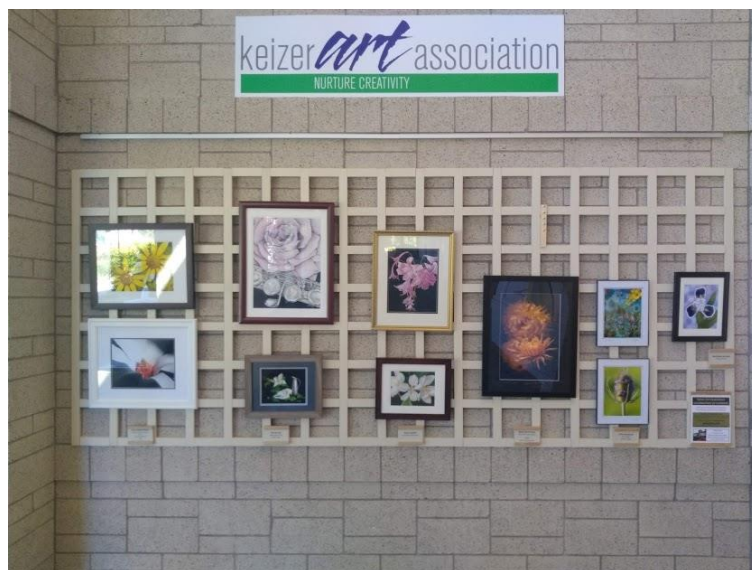

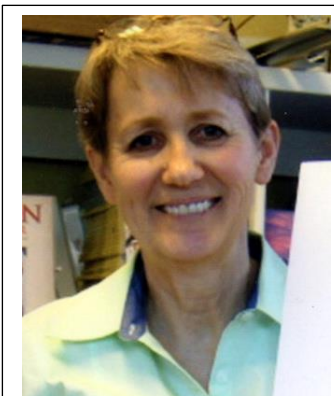

Per Kathy Haney:

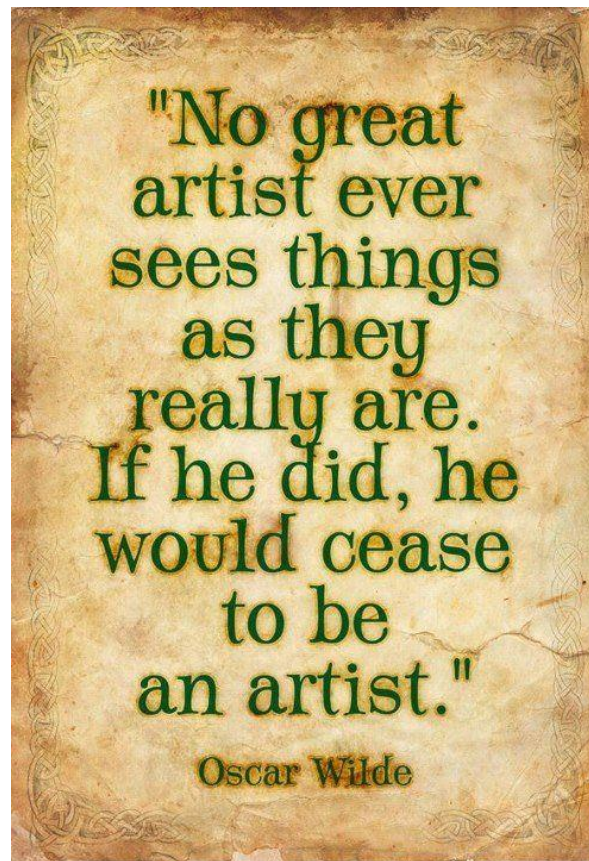
“The two week quilting class that Kathy was going to teach on Sept 16 and Sept 23 has been cancelled also due to the hazardous air in Keizer/Salem.”
