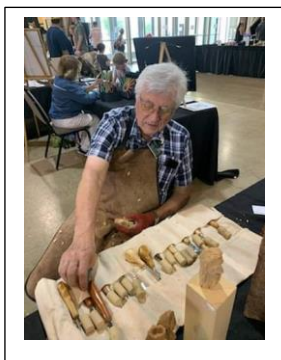

## KAA at the Oregon State Fair

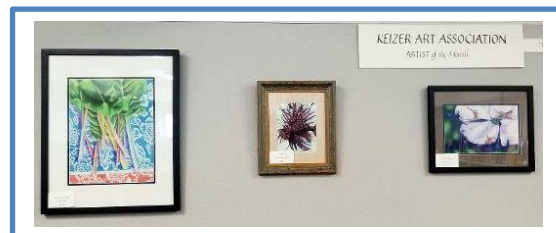
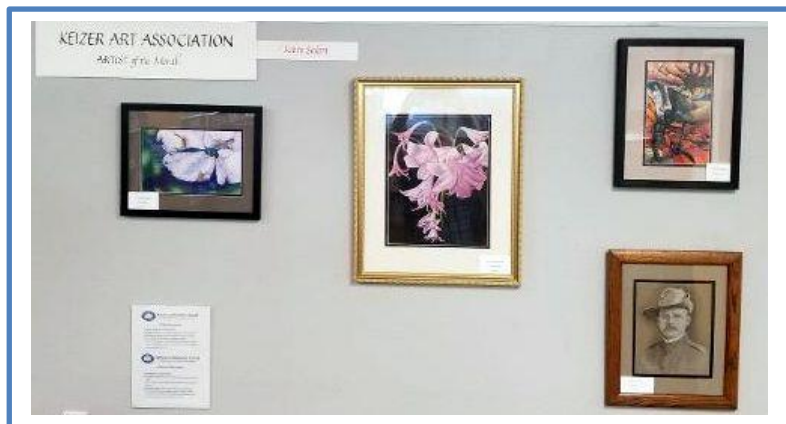

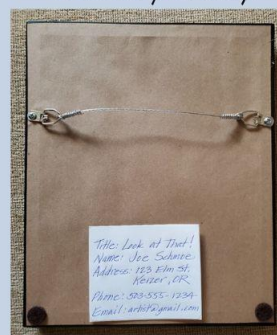
