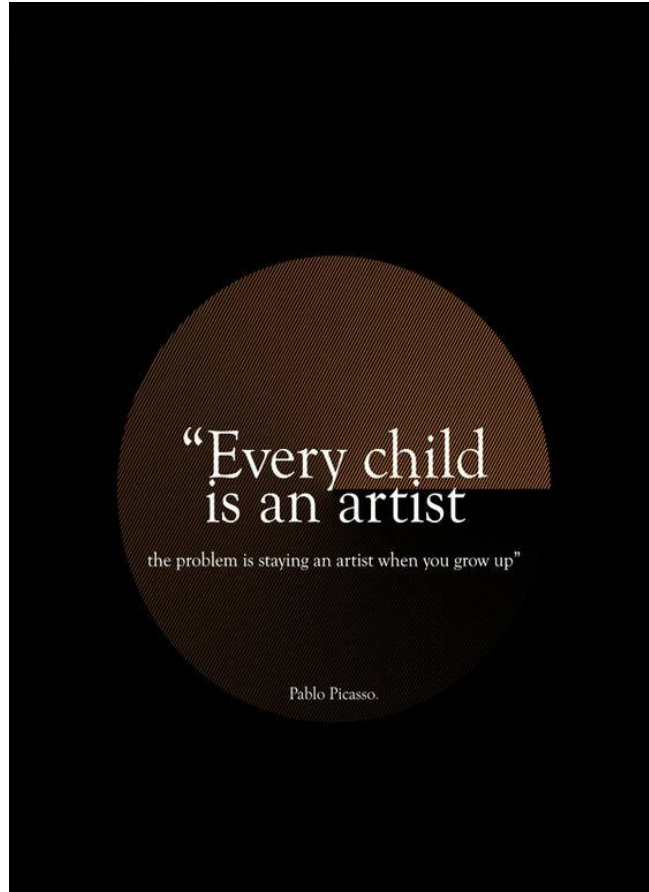
JULY, 2018, "WATER, WATER EVERYWHERE"

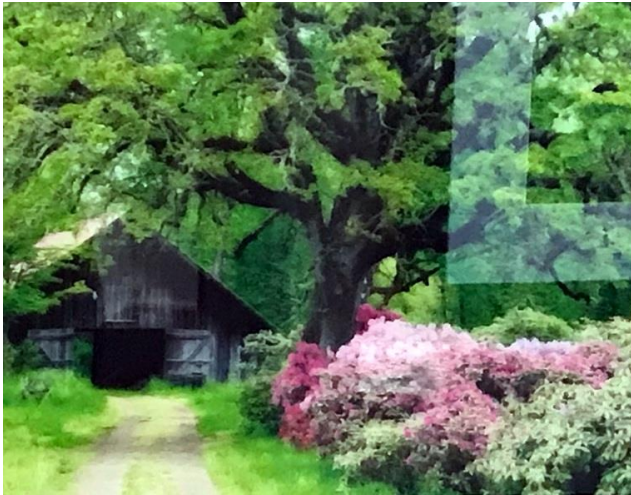

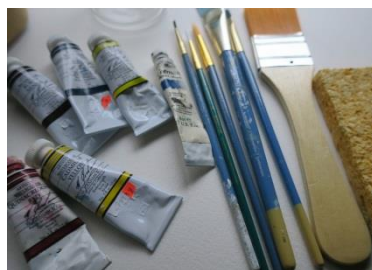
