This show is open to all artists! All media and any subject may be entered into this December Artist Showcase.


Children ages 4 – 14 are encouraged to enter this show as well.

"This piece had personality and charm in excess. What moved me to give the highest award was the skill in using this pointillistic approach to achieve not only the texture, but the shading. Look closely at this artist's work. Many labor hours went into this."

JURORS' MERIT AWARD: "The Old Oak", watercolor, Nola Pear



"Significant use of the medium to create texture and a wide value range. It was a nice feeling to the subject matter. This artist is definitely good enough to invest in artist quality paints and paper."




Believe it or not, this is Burning on Watercolor Paper. One would think that you have to turn the heat down, but actually it burns a little hotter while still being careful to not burn through.
