**INTAKE** is Wednesday, February 1st, 3 – 6 pm.

**THE ARTISTS' RECEPTION** will be held Saturday, February 4<sup>th</sup> from 2 – 4 pm.

The public, artists, family and friends are invited to attend the reception. Awards will be presented at this time. Artists who are exhibiting works are encouraged to attend as the public enjoys meeting you and having conversation with you.

This show runs from February 2nd through February 28th.

### **THE FOLLOWING ARE GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR ALL KAA SHOWS:**

The Keizer Art Association reserves the right to determine if art submitted meets the family friendly standards as determined by the Board of Directors. The Board also reserves the right to jury submitted art for appropriateness and size, as space limitations mandate. Please refer to guidelines below for further details

#### **Art Media**

- 2D - Two dimensional pieces, such as: watercolor, oil, acrylic, mixed media, colored pencil or fabric art. Art larger than 48" x 48" will not be accepted into the show.
- Photography – Any image created within the confines of a camera and using camera related adjustments in post processing for lighting, contrast, color, sharpness, cropping, etc. Images larger than 48" x 48" will not be accepted into the show.
- Digital Art – Photos edited and changed using artistic filter adjustments in post processing, photo painting, digital collages, integrated art, digital painting or any other artistic rendition using a computer and software. Images larger than 48" x 48" will not be accepted into the show.
- 3D – Three-dimensional media occupies space defined through the dimensions of height, width and depth. Art larger than 48" x 48" will not be accepted into the show.

## Entry Mandates

- All work must be original to the artist.
- All media are acceptable and the show is open to all McNary High School artists.
- Jewelry and other small objects should be displayed in a secure, professional manner.
- Artwork exhibited in this gallery within the past two years will not be received.
- Up to four entries per artist are permitted.
- Art must not exceed 48" x 48".
- Wall art must have a sturdy hanger. Acceptable hangers **must be compatible with our hanging system**
- Entry back must have card with artist's name, telephone number, medium and title of the piece.
- Award winners of this show should be ready, if they desire, to show their art at the Keizer Civic Center complete with frames, mats and glass for the month of March. Winners of awards will be contacted by Terry Dempsey, KAA board member, regarding participation in the show at the Keizer Civic Center.

This exhibit is juried and ribbons will be awarded for best of show, judge's merit award, first, second and third place in each of these categories: 2-D art, photography, 3-D art, and digital art. The decision of the judge(s) is final. A \$100 award will be given to the artist of the best of show.

- The intake is Wednesday, February 1st, 3 – 6 pm at the gallery.
- Pick up art on Wednesday, March 1st, 3 – 6 pm at the gallery.
