April First Tuesday Meet-Up with Billie Larson & Friends, a gathering of ladies interested in pine needle basketry that gave us a fabulous presentation of pine needle baskets. These ladies meet at the Center 50+ in Salem to design, build and talk about pine needle basketry. They told us about how to gather and prepare pine needles, as well as other items used to fabricate the baskets. Of special interest were the variety of items used to start the center of a basket, anything from tightly coiled pine needles to brooches, pierced porcelain bowls or beadwork. Pine needles can also be used to build long rope-like lengths that could be used to decorate or enhance driftwood or other natural elements. Some of their baskets contained natural or subtle colors, others were brightly colored with synthetic sinews that created beautiful patterns in their bowls. We had announcements, show & tell, door prizes, refreshments and a wonderful time with talented artists.

Learn all about and try your hand at scratchboard in this one-day workshop. Scratchboard is a smooth, white clay board covered in a layer of black India ink. You draw by scratching or scraping away the ink to reveal the white underneath. It is like drawing, but in reverse. Add color with fast-drying inks if you wish, then scratch again to reveal highlights. It is easy and it's very fun!

SPRINGTIME WATERCOLOR TECHNIQUES FOR BEGINNERS with Michelle Myers
