Wednesday, July 11, 10 am to 1 pm Beginning Watercolor Painting: Have always been curious about watercolor painting but didn't know where to start? Here is the place to start. Wednesday, July 18, 10 am to 1 pm Beginning Watercolor Painting Landscapes: Hills, trees, mountains, lakes and oceans -this class will cover a variety of techniques on how to create landscapes in watercolor. Wednesday, July 25, 10 am to 1 pm Watercolor Painting White Trees: Create an original (much easier than it looks) treescape watercolor painting using wet into wet techniques and masking fluid. Thursday, July 12, 10 am to 1 pm Beginning Paper Collage (on a flat surface): This class will review the variety of materials in building your own collage. You have the option of using a design provided or a free exploration of items provided. All materials provided. Cost: \$25 Materials fee: \$10 paid directly to instructor on class day. **Monday, July 30, 1 pm to 4 pm Beginning Paper Collage (decoupage) Boxes:** In this class we will learn about the basic materials and techniques of collage. Then we will collage several paper boxes with by choosing your own design or one provided. All materials provided. Cost: \$25 Materials fee: \$10 paid directly to instructor on class day.
