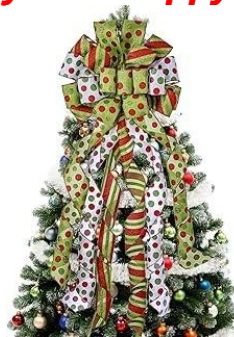

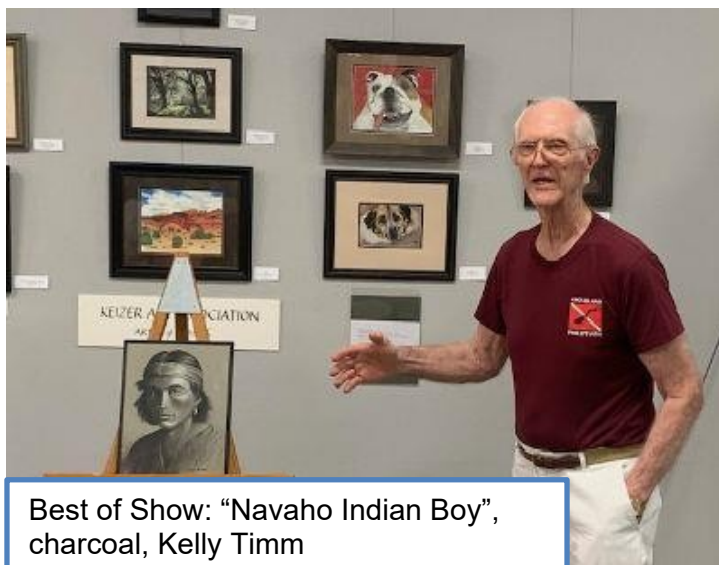

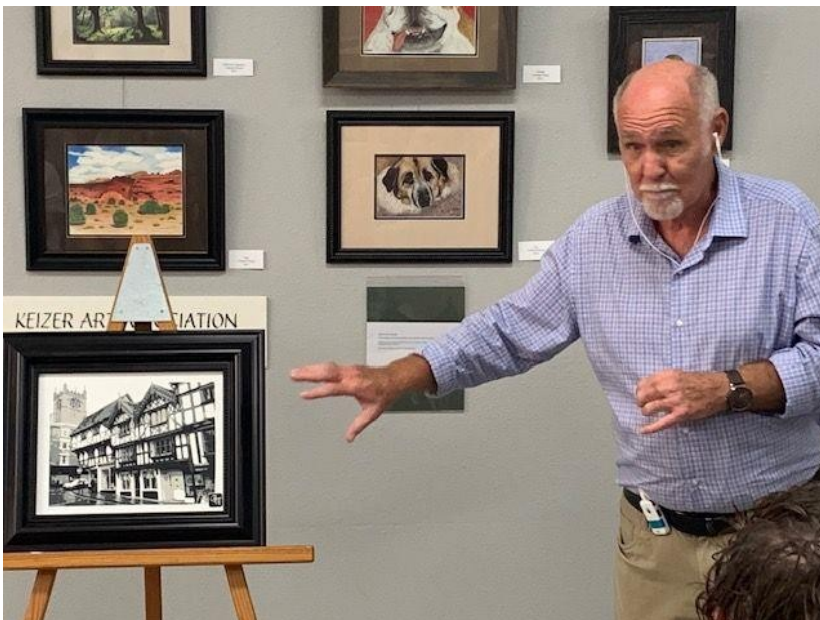

## INTRODUCTION TO OIL PAINTING

This workshop is comprised of eight three-hour sessions occurring on Tuesday afternoons. You will learn the fundamentals of oil painting step-by-step, ending the course with a copy of the landscape Campo de Lavando by Miguel Peidro.

We will discuss the various types of paint, mediums and solvents. You will learn about the various brush types and how to clean them in an environmentally friendly way. Safety precautions will be stressed.

You will gain a basic understanding of color theory and value, as well as the various techniques of oil painting. This course is designed for students with no previous drawing or painting experience or for those artists experienced in other mediums looking to broaden their skills.
