The February show is a new KAA show. Art to exhibit what Love Letters mean to each of you. Entries in this show will be the artist's choice of subject and medium.

INTAKE is Wednesday, February 4th, 3 – 6 pm.

RECEPTION will be Saturday, February 7th from 2 – 4 pm.

The public, artists, family and friends are invited to attend the reception. Awards will be presented at this time. Artists who are exhibiting works are encouraged to attend as the public enjoys meeting you and having conversation with you.

This show runs from February 5th through March 3rd.

THE FOLLOWING ARE GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR ALL KAA SHOWS:

The Keizer Art Association reserves the right to determine if art submitted meets the family friendly standards as determined by the Board of Directors. The Board also reserves the right to jury submitted art for appropriateness and size, as space limitations mandate. **No AI may be entered in the show.** Please refer to guidelines below for further details

Art Media

- 2D - Two-dimensional pieces, such as: watercolor, oil, acrylic, mixed media, colored pencil or fabric art. Art larger than 48" x 48" will not be accepted into the show.
- Photography – Any image created within the confines of a camera and using camera related adjustments in post processing for lighting, contrast, color, sharpness, cropping, etc. Images larger than 48" x 48" will not be accepted into the show.
- Digital Art – Photos edited and changed using artistic filter adjustments in post processing, photo painting, digital collages, integrated art, digital painting or any other artistic rendition using a computer and software. Images larger than 48" x 48" will not be accepted into the show.
- 3D – Three-dimensional media occupies space defined through the dimensions of height, width and depth. Art larger than 48" x 48" will not be accepted into the show.
- Youth Art may be entered by those ages 4 years old to 14 years old. Art larger than 48" x 48" will not be accepted into the show.

Entry Mandates

- All artwork must be original to the artist
- All media are acceptable and the show is open to all artists.
- Edges of unframed wall art must be suitably finished (no visible staples/jagged edges).
- Jewelry and other small objects should be displayed in a secure, professional manner.

- Artwork exhibited in this gallery within the past two years is not acceptable, even with color or digital alterations.
- Up to four entries per artist are permitted.
- Art must not exceed 48" x 48".
- Wall art must have a sturdy hanger. Hangers **must be compatible with our hanging system**: A wire in the top third of the piece of art or another built in hanger in the back of the piece of art. **Sawtooth hangers are not acceptable**. When there is a question regarding the appropriateness of the hanger, one of the board members at intake will try to hang the art. Their decision to accept or reject the hanger will be final.
- **Please list your entries on the online Entry Form.** Submission of the online entry form represents your signature and signifies your agreement of the terms as shown on the form. If you are unable to use the online entry form, you may fill one out an entry form at intake in the classroom. If you are unable to pay online, you may pay at intake in the gallery.
- Entry back must have card with artist's name, telephone number, medium and title of the art.
- **Civic Center Show.** Award winners of this show should be ready, if they desire, to show their art at the Keizer Civic Center complete with frames, mat and/or glass for the month of March. The winning art will be moved over to the Civic Center Show by Linda Houton, a KAA volunteer. If you are not interested in participating in the Civic Center Show, please email KAA at keizerartassociation@gmail.com to let us know of your decision.

Awards

This exhibit is juried and ribbons will be awarded for best of show and for juror's merit award; and for first, second and third place in each of these categories: 2-D art, photography, digital art, 3D art and youth art. The decision of the judge(s) is final. A \$100 award will be given to the artist of the best of show.

Entry Fees

- Members: \$10 for first piece; \$15 for two pieces; \$15 for diptychs and triptychs (a single work of art displayed on two or three panels); \$20 for three pieces; \$25 for four pieces.
- Non-Members: \$20 for first piece; \$25 for two pieces; \$25 for diptychs and triptychs; \$30 for three pieces; \$35 for four pieces.
- Youth: \$5 for up to two pieces. This division is open to all youth (4 – 14 years of age).

Sale of Art

Commission fee for sales is 70% to the artist and 30% to KAA.

Important Dates

- Intake is Wednesday, February 4th from 3 – 6 pm in the KAA Gallery. Pick-up of art is Wednesday, February 4th, from 3 – 6 pm in the KAA classroom.
- **Art entered in KAA shows must be picked up on the pick-up date stated in this prospectus, unless you have previously made arrangements to pick up your art within a week of the pick-up date. KAA insurance lapses on pick-up date. Art work not picked up within 30 days of pickup date will become the property of KAA.**

A signed entry form and fees must accompany your entry.
