Children ages 4 through 14 are encouraged to enter this show.

**INTAKE** is Wednesday, April 29th from 3 to 6 pm in the gallery. Or you may enter using the entry form on the KAA website.

**RECEPTION** will be on Saturday, May 2nd from 2 to 4 pm.

Plan now to participate in this show. Some wonderful artwork will be shown. The public, artists, family and friends are invited to attend. Awards will be presented at this time. Artists who are exhibiting works are encouraged to attend as the public enjoys meeting you and communicating with you.

The show will run April 30th through June 2nd.

### **THE FOLLOWING ARE GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR ALL KAA SHOWS**

The Keizer Art Association reserves the right to determine if art submitted meets the family friendly standards as determined by the Board of Directors. No Artificial Intelligence (AI) generated art will be accepted. This is the link to the KAA “AI” Policy: <http://keizerarts.com/policies/ai/> The Board also reserves the right to jury submitted art for size, as space limitations mandate. Please refer to guidelines below for further details.

#### **Art Media**

- 2D – inch as: watercolor, oil, acrylic, mixed media, colored pencil or fabric art, not to exceed 48 x 48 inches.
- Photography – any image created within the confines of a camera and using camera related adjustments in post processing for lighting, contrast, color, sharpness, cropping, etc., not exceed 48 x 48 inches.
- Digital Art – Photos edited and changed using artistic filter adjustments in post processing, photo painting, digital collages, integrated art, digital painting, or any other artistic rendition using a computer and software, not to exceed 48 x 48 inches.
- 3D – Three-dimensional media occupies space defined through the dimensions of height, width, and depth, not to exceed 24 x 24 inches. Any entry with small or loose parts and/or live plants must be entered sealed in a container. All entries must not expect any upkeep during the show.
- Youth Art – Any of the above media entered by children 4 through 14 years of age.

#### **Entry Mandates**

- All work must be original by the artist.
- All media are acceptable and the show is open to all artists.
- Jewelry and other small objects should be shown in a professional manner

- Artwork exhibited in this gallery within the past two years is not acceptable **even with color or digital alterations.**
- Up to four entries per artist are permitted.
- **Wall art must have sturdy hangers,** Acceptable hangers must be compatible with our hanging system: A wire in the top third of the piece or art or another build in hanger in the back of the piece of art. **Sawtooth hangers are not acceptable.** When there is a question regarding the appropriateness of the hanger, one of the KAA board members at intake will attempt to hang the art. The board member's decision to accept to reject the hanger will be final.
- **Please list your entries on the online Entry Form.** Submission of the online entry for represents your signature and signifies your agreement of the terms as shown on the form. If you are unable to use the online entry form, you may fill one out at intake in the gallery. If you cannot pay online, you may pay at intake in the gallery.
- **Civic Center Show.** Award winners of this show should to be ready, if they desire, to show their art at the Keizer Civic Center complete with frames, mats and/or glass for the month of February. The winning art will be moved over to the Civic Center Show by Linda Houton, a KAA volunteer. If you are not interested in participating in the Civic Center Show, please email KAA at [keizerartassociation@gmail.com](mailto:keizerartassociation@gmail.com) to let us know of your decision.

### Awards

- This exhibit is judged and awards will be announced for the best of show, for juror's merit award and for first, second and third place. Awards include \$100 to the artist of the best of show. The decision of the judge(s) is final.

### Entry Fees

- Members: \$10 for first piece; \$15 for two pieces; \$15 for diptychs and triptychs (a single work of art displayed on two or three panels; \$20 for three pieces; \$25 for four pieces.
- Non-Members: \$20 for first piece; \$25 for two pieces; \$25 for diptychs and triptychs; \$30 for three pieces; and \$35 for four pieces.
- Youth: \$5 for one or two pieces. This division is open to all youth. Ages 4 through 14 years.

### Sale of Art

- Commission fee for sales is 70% to the artist and 30% to KAA.

### Important Dates

- Intake is Wednesday, April 29th from 3 to 6 in the gallery.
- Pickup of art is Wednesday, June 3rd from 3 to 6 pm in the KAA classroom. **Art entered in KAA shows must be picked up on the pick-up date state in the prospectus, unless you have previously made arrangements to pick up your art within a week. Or unless you have agreed to show your art in the Civic Center show for 30 additional days. KAA insurance lapses on pick-up date or at the end of the Civic Center show. Art not picked up within 30 days of pick-up date, or 30 days at of the end of Civic Center show, will become the property of KAA.**

**A signed entry form and fees must accompany your entry.** Entry forms are available on the KAA website. You may type in your information right on the online form. You may pay your fee on the same site. Please bring your receipt of payment to intake. If you cannot complete an entry form online, you may fill one out at intake. If you cannot pay online, you may pay in the gallery at intake.
